New payment arrangements are now in place and work to improve the road layout is underway.

New payment arrangements and road improvements to ease congestion at the Dartford Crossing.

New payment arrangements

- You can no longer pay the Dartford Crossing charge at the barriers.
- Instead, you need to pay in advance of your journey or by midnight the following day.
- You can save up to one-third on every crossing by setting up a pre-pay account.
- Alternatively, you can make one-off payments online, by phone, at Payzone retail outlets or in advance by post.
- Drivers who don't pay the charge will face a penalty.
- It is still free to use the Crossing between 10pm and 6am.

Road improvements

- Major improvement works are underway and will continue until spring 2015.
- The works will replace the current 27 lanes and payment booths with a much simpler road layout with four lanes in each direction.
- New traffic management measures are also being installed on the northbound approach to the tunnels to maintain safety and manage over-sized vehicles and those carrying dangerous goods.
