


ALTEA


After lunch we will go to visit the beautiful town.



Canelobre Caves: a natural group of prehistoric caves installed in the heart of the

Cabeçó d'Or mountain range (meaning Gold Head, in English). Considered to be one of the main geological treasures of the province of Alicante, the inside of these caves boasts a series of rock formations that attract thousands of tourists every year.

CANALOBRE CAVES

Entering Busot is like traveling back in time to the Jurassic. You do not believe it? You just have to discover the Canelobre Caves andbe surprisedby incredibleviews. These caves are one of the main attractions of the Alicante town and are a clear example of a karst cavity.

Within the Canelobre Caves thereis of а space more than 80,000 square meters that canbeaccessed through 45metertunnel in which water have androck given rise toimpressive shapes, such as stalactites, stalagmites, columns and jellyfish.

If we talk about years, this cave is more than 145 million years old.

Travel inside these caves anddiscover the treasures all housed inside. You canfind one of the highest vaultsin allof Spain, with a height of 70 meters. It ifit werethe vaultof isas cathedral, it evenhas prominent elements that make a simile with the "Holy Family." We also find the Canelobre, a stalagmite in the center of the room that is more than 100,000 years old.

CHOCOLATE MUSEUM

In the afternoon visit the famous and sweet CHOCOLATE MUSEUM. The Valor Chocolate Museum, created in 1998, was recognized by the Generalitat Valenciana in 2008 as the Valencian Chocolate Museum.

In its day it was the small family factory, and there you will be able about the chocolate learn to and the making process entirehistory of Chocolates Valor fromits birthto thepresent, passing throughthe 5 generations of master chocolatiers who have run it.

In addition, it has one of the best collections of machinery in the chocolate industry from different eras, from the times when cocoa was ground on stone to the presentday.

ELCHE

Elche has as many Places of interest as centuries of history, and its history dates back to the Neolithic, where the first settlers lefttraces of their presence. The site of currentElche was inhabited various by peoplesand culturesuntil the 5th century BC.The Iberiancity of Ilici was founded.The enigmatic sculpture of the Lady of Elche, one ofthe most relevant archaeological finds in our country, belongs to this culture.

The Romans followed the **Iberiansand** theArabs. who introduced irrigation and to whom weowe the basis of what is today one of its most recognizable signs of identity: the Palmeral of Elche. Thispalm forest, a World Heritage Site, boasts of being the largest of itskind in Europe, althoughit isbelieved that in Arab timesit musthave been even larger. Withmore than 200,000 palm trees.We will visit the Huertodel Cura, Museum of the Palm of Tree.Museum the **Festa** (entranceincluded) Afterwards we willgo to eat at typical restaurant. MENU
